


# **Rapid Antigen Tests (RAT)**

# **Community Assistance to Access Support Services**

We are hoping to have the support of a new volunteer to join our team to assist our clients with registering for to services like My Aged Care, Carers SA as well as preparing an Advanced Care Plan.
